Spring Exemplification

The weekend will begin with the Hospitality evening on Friday, April 13. There will be ample opportunity for you to meet and socialize with Sir Knights from all of the Assemblies in District 1. Dress for Friday evening is casual.

Saturday morning features the Exemplification ceremony for the men and a Ladies Brunch for the wives or significant others. Dress for the Exemplification is Full Service Regalia. If you do not have service regalia, you may appear in Social regalia. For the Ladies, dress for the Brunch is fancy church clothes.
